

#### PLASTIC BOTTLE LIDS

Some members have been kindly letting me have plastic milk bottle tops to raise funds for: 1. London Air Ambulance - tops bearing the numbers 2 or 4 in a triangle

2. Matthew Project in Norfolk - everything else. This was for a drugs rehabilitation and education programme.

It has recently been discovered that the Matthew Project is no longer accepting plastic for recycling, due to the Chinese ban on importing UK waste. This took effect at the end of January. Hillingdon accepts plastic for recycling, so all is not lost, as the local authority will benefit. I am still able to recycle milk bottle tops with numbers 2 or 4, for the London Air Ambulance. Recycling takes place in the U.K. so is not affected by the Chinese ban. Thank you for your support to date and I look forward to this continuing in the future.
