A SPECIAL MESSAGE FROM HAZEL: 'These past 3 weeks, no doubt you have been dismayed at the news from Khartoum, Sudan about the civil war raging there and in other areas including Darfur. The future of the country as a whole is, at the moment, at stake. Our church and its members have been faithful supporters of KIDS FOR KIDS, a charity I have volunteered for the whole of its 22 year existence. International aid agencies have had to flee for their lives from Khartoum and Darfur. Kids for Kids can continue its work in Darfur carried out by local staff and community volunteers despite the danger to them also. Attached is, understandably, an Emergency Appeal from KIDS FOR KIDS, which, should you feel moved to respond to, shows details of how to do so. I have been associated with Sudan since its independence in 1956 and never, until now, has a shot been fired or a bomb dropped on Khartoum, a warm, friendly, gentle city which I have visited many times and also Darfur. Should you wish to know more about the country or current situation I would be happy to talk to you"
