The President and Vice-President of the Methodist Conference have <u>released a statement</u> on the situation in Israel and Palestine. They have written to the UK Government to ask them to work for peace in the region and are asking you to join them in praying for those affected by the attacks. The Methodist Church has published <u>resources, prayers, background and reflections</u>.
